## A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CHEROKEE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT APPOINTING A NEW BOARD MEMBER TO SERVE IN THE BOARD SEAT VACATED BY PHIL GARRISON

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2020, Director Phil Garrison resigned in writing effective immediately from his position as a member of the Cherokee Metropolitan District's Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, §32-1-905 C.R.S., Directors – Organization of Board-Vacancies, provides, in relevant part, as follows: (1) A Director's office shall be deemed to be vacant upon the occurrence of any one of the following events prior to the expiration of the term of office: ... (c) if a person was duly elected or appointed submits a written resignation to the Board;

WHEREAS, pursuant to §32-1-905 C.R.S., Mr. Garrison's Board seat is deemed vacant, and;

WHEREAS, the Board desires to appoint a new Director to fill the vacancy left by Mr. Garrison for the remainder of his term to serve until such time of the next regular election of May 3, 2022; and, if within sixty days of the occurrence of any vacancy, the Board fails, neglects, or refuses to appoint a Director from the pool of any duly qualified, willing candidates, the Board of County Commissioners of the county which approved the organizational petition may appoint a Director to fill such vacancy,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Cherokee Metropolitan District as follows:

Having reviewed interested individuals' qualifications and eligibility for the position, the Board hereby appoints to fill the vacant Board position and to serve until May 3, 2022.
